## **CIRCULAR TO PROFESSIONAL INSTITUTES**

# PROVISION OF A BATHROOM THAT CAN BE RETROFITTED FOR THE ELDERLY PERSONS AND WHEELCHAIR USERS

# Objective

This circular is to inform qualified persons, developers and building owners of the requirement to provide in the residential unit at least one bathroom that can be retrofitted for the elderly persons and wheelchair users when the need arises.

## **Effective date**

The requirement will apply to all new erections except for detached, semidetached and terraced houses submitted to the Building and Construction Authority (BCA) from 1 April 2007.

## **Background**

As a continuous effort to promote a barrier-free built environment and to keep the Code on Barrier-Free Accessibility in Buildings updated and relevant with the time, BCA has been reviewing the Code regularly in consultation with the stakeholders and end-users. In view of the rapidly aging population, the requirement is implemented as an interim measure before the targeted completion of the review of the Code in mid 2007.

# Bathroom that can be retrofitted for the elderly persons and wheelchair users

- There shall be at least one bathroom in every residential unit that can be retrofitted for the elderly persons and wheelchair users when the need arises.
- 2 The bathroom shall be located at the same level as the entrance of the unit.
- The width of the access route leading to the bathroom, or the room where the bathroom is, shall be 1000 mm minimum, subject to the provisions in Table A.
- The doorway of the bathroom and the clear space in front of the doorway shall comply with the dimensions in Table A.

- 5 There shall be an unobstructed space of not less than 1000 mm in diameter next to the doorway within the bathroom.
- The change in level of the floor surface at the doorway of the bathroom shall not be more than 25 mm.
- Provision shall be made for retrofitting the necessary grab bars in the bathroom in accordance with clause 4.3 of the Code on Barrier-Free Accessibility in Buildings.

# Bathroom for future retrofitting sited in another room


If the bathroom for future retrofitting is accessed through another room, the clear opening of the doorway of the room shall comply with the minimum dimension specified in Table A.

## **Entrance to the unit**

- 9 The difference in levels between the floor of the entrance to the unit and the abutting common area shall not be more than 50 mm.
- 10 The doorway of the entrance shall be 800 mm minimum for a single leaf door. If the doorway has two independently operated door leaves, at least one active leaf shall be 800 mm minimum.
- 11 The maneuvering space at the entrance shall be in accordance with clause 3.5.4 of the Code on Barrier-Free Accessibility in Buildings.

## **Switches and Socket Outlets**

12 The switches and socket outlets shall be provided at a height of between 600mm and 1200mm from the finished floor level.
