INTRODUCTION OF THE MULTI-SKILLING SCHEME AS AN ALTERNATIVE UPGRADING PATHWAY FOR CONSTRUCTION WORK PERMIT HOLDERS (WPHS)

This circular informs the industry of the introduction of the Multi-Skilling Scheme.

- The Building and Construction Authority will be introducing a new Multi-Skilling Scheme to provide an alternative pathway for the industry to upgrade their workers as "Higher Skilled" R1 workers. The new Multi-Skilling Scheme, conceptualised in consultation with Singapore Contractors Association Limited (SCAL), complements the CoreTrade Scheme. CoreTrade recognises workers specialising in key construction trades, whereas the Multi-Skilling Scheme registers workers competent in multiple trade skills. Multi-Skilled workers offer greater flexibility in deployment on site and help to enhance productivity by reducing productivity downtime.
- 3 BCA will start to register construction workers who would like to be qualified as Multi-Skilled from 1 Jul 2012. The following are the criteria to qualify as Multi-Skilled:
 - a) 4 years of construction experience in Singapore; and
 - b) 2 acceptable certifications (see Annex B for more details)

Multi-skilled workers would be subjected to Continuing Education & Training (CET) requirements every 2 years.

4 Application for registration as a Multi-Skilled worker may be submitted to BCA online at http://www.bca.gov.sg starting from 1 July 2012.

Details of the Multi-Skilling Scheme

The following are the criteria for a work permit holder (WPH) to qualify for registration to be a Multi-Skilled worker:

- 1) Having 2 acceptable certifications:
 - a. For first certification:
 - i. Any SEC or SEC(K) certifications; or
 - ii. Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) certification, for Malaysian WPH.
 - b. For second certification:
 - i. Any SEC(K) trade certification in a <u>different</u> trade from the first certification (as listed in Annex B).
- 2) Having a minimum of 4 years of construction experience in Singapore:
 - a. During registration, the employer will need to produce documents showing the WPH's years of working experience in Singapore.
- 3) Upon successful registration, subject to Continuing Education & Training (CET) requirements every 2 years. If the CET requirement is not met within 60 days of deadline for renewal of registration, the Multi-Skilling registration would be considered as lapsed and the WPH needs to re-register.
