CHANGES TO THE GREEN MARK INCENTIVE SCHEME FOR DESIGN PROTOTYPE (GMIS-DP)

Background

1. BCA rolled out the GMIS-DP scheme on 1 December 2010. The scheme aims to encourage developers and building owners to strive for greater energy efficiency in buildings by placing more emphasis at the design stage. Funding support is available for the engagement of environmentally sustainable design (ESD)¹ consultants to conduct collaborative design workshops and assist in simulation studies early in the project to achieve a breakthrough and optimal design for green buildings. Review of the GMIS-DP Scheme

2. With numerous enquiries from industry stakeholders and the experience from the implementation of 2 projects, a mid-term review of the scheme was conducted.

3. Taking into consideration feedback from industry stakeholders, the following will take effect on 1 May 2013:

a. The level of funding support is revised to be an <u>outcome-based</u>. With the outcome-based, the amount of funding obtained will depend on the real energy savings verified during building operation phase, subject to the funding cap. See Figure 1 for details.

¹ Environmentally Sustainable Design (ESD) consultants have a thorough understanding of the integrated design approach, implementing energy efficient measures in buildings and performing in-depth computer simulation for buildings.

Note: The co-funding basis with up to 70% support of qualifying costs still applies

b. In addition, we are introducing the Energy Efficiency Index (EEI) as a new pre-requisite requirement. The EEI will serve as a best practice benchmark indicator for energy efficiency. See Figure 2 for details.

4. The enhanced GMIS-DP scheme will take effect from 01 May 2013 till 1 December 2014 or when the GMIS-DP fund is fully committed, whichever is earlier.
