EXPANSION OF LODGEMENT SCHEME FOR STREET PLAN SUBMISSION

- 1. On 1 April last year, we have implemented the lodgement scheme for street plans submission for only the landed housing development not affected by the road reserve lines.
- 2. Under the scheme, a Professional Engineer ("PE") will prepare the street plans in accordance with the Street Works Act ("the Act") and its Regulations ("the Regulations"), and declare compliance with the Act and the Regulations when he lodges the street plans with LTA. LTA will acknowledges receipt of the lodgement by issuing an acknowledgement letter.
- As part of our continuous effort to streamline and to facilitate approval 3. procedures, we are pleased to inform you that with effect from 9 January 2006, the lodgement scheme will be expanded to include the following types of development, which are not affected by the road reserve lines:
 - (a) residential (including landed housing);
 - (b) industrial;
 - (c) educational institution;
 - (d) place of worship;
 - (e) health and medical care establishment;
 - (f) sports and recreation centre;
 - (g) civic and community institution;
 - (h) building designated for conservation under the Planning Act.

- 4. Please note that the lodgment scheme will not be applicable for street plans that involve the following types of works:
 - (a) the construction of new street(s);
 - (b) the continuation of existing street(s);
 - (c) the adaptation of a street made for foot traffic only for carriage traffic;
 - (d) the introduction or modification of any road related facilities*;
 - (e) the introduction or relocation of any covered linkway
- 5. Similar to the lodgement scheme implemented last April, the lodgement shall be made on the lodgement form "LTA/RT/BP-3". A copy of the revised form "LTA/RT/BP-3" is attached in Annex A for reference.
- 6. Please also note that prior to lodging the street plans submission, the corresponding development proposal must obtain LTA's Development Control ("DC") clearance for its layout, such as access arrangement/location. The development proposal must also obtain the Written Permission ("WP") from the Competent Authority and attach it together with the lodgement of plans with us. Application for clearance for issuance of Certificate of Statutory Completion ("CSC") is still required upon completion of the street works, based on the lodged street plans.

- 6. Street Plans for proposed development affected by road safeguarding lines, or comprise new street submitted under Section 18 of the Street Works Act, or introduction or modification of any road related facilities⁺, or introduction or relocation of any covered linkways are not to be lodged.
- 7. Street Plans are to be lodged when there are amendments made to the original lodged Street Plans.
