

APPLICABILITY OF CIVIL DEFENCE SHELTER ACT

I refer to our circular (ref: CD/SB/C/A1/3) dated 1st Jun 2001 on the above subject issue and a copy of which is enclosed for your easy reference.

- As explained in the 1st Jun 2001 circular, Additions & Alterations (A&A) and reconstruction (except for **total demolition** and rebuilt cases) of existing houses/ flats do not come under the Civil Defence Shelter Act (CDSA) 1997, and therefore shelters are not required in these proposals. However, we like to clarify that in the **rebuilding** of a house where only its party wall(s) with their embedded columns and supporting beams, if any, are retained, **a Household Shelter** is required for this rebuilt house as it is considered as a new house under the CDSA 1997.
