REPLACEMENT AIR FOR ENGINEERED SMOKE CONTROL SYSTEM

In industrial premises or for large enclosed spaces where engineered smoke control system is designed and installed, it was a practice to design replacement air to be induced via openings fitted with roller shutters at the unit frontage. When closed, these roller shutters will open automatically once receiving a fire signal from the building fire alarm system or dedicated local smoke detectors.

- 2. A study has been carried out to determine the suitability of openings installed with automatic roller shutters as a means of replacement air inlets for engineered smoke control system. It was found that the automatic roller shutters installed at these openings, normally at the frontage of warehouse / factory unit, are lockable type and when they are locked down, these roller shutters could not be opened automatically to serve as replacement air inlets for the effective operation of the engineered smoke control. It is crucial that replacement air is readily available at all time so as not to jeopardise the effectiveness of the design of the engineered smoke control system.
- 3. With immediate effect, if automatic roller shutters are to be used at replacement air inlets in the design and installation of engineered smoke control system, they shall be of perforated type having the required effective free area for the effective operation of the engineered smoke control system.
