

REDAS Industry Sharing Series (2nd) Virtual Design and Construction (VDC): A Game Changer for Effective Collaboration 25 April 2016 (Monday)

In 2015, BCA launched its 2nd BIM Roadmap to bring the built environment industry's productivity drive to the next higher level. The emphasis is to encourage industry practitioners from developers to consultants and contractors to embrace an integrated approach in the design, construction and operation of construction projects; facilitate collaboration among the stakeholders and its value chain partners in using BIM, Virtual Design and Construction (VDC) methodology and Design for Manufacturing and Assembly (DfMA) for higher productivity gain moving forward, and to promote the creation of a connected BIM environment for the adoption of more viable impactful construction technologies in achieving significant productivity improvements in the future.

VDC is a fairly new concept to most developers and its value chain partners. It enables a new level of transparency which allows to collaborate more effectively, conduct accurate constructability analyses, improve estimating, maintain greater schedule and cost control.

This Industry Sharing Session aims to create the awareness of how VDC can benefit the developers and its value chain partners in establishing a workable and collaborative BIM framework that facilitates VDC adoption, as well as to identify the challenges faced in VDC implementation. Invited industry experts will share their experience of implementing VDC in their respective organizations, valuable insights on the success factors, benefits and challenges to be taken into consideration when implementing VDC.
