# AMENDMENTS TO PART K OF APPROVED DOCUMENT ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF BUILDING CONTROL UNDER THE BUILDING CONTROL REGULATIONS 2003

- (A) IMPLEMENTATION OF SS 626:2017 CODE OF PRACTICE FOR DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ESCALATORS AND MOVING WALKS
- (B) NEW TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR LIFTS AND ESCALATORS

## **OBJECTIVE**

The purpose of this circular is to provide information on the following amendments to the Approved Document, Part K<sup>1</sup>:

- a) Implementation of SS 626:2017 Code of Practice for Design, Installation and Maintenance of Escalators and Moving Walks; and
- b) New requirements for lifts and escalators.
- (A) IMPLEMENTATION OF SS 626:2017 CODE OF PRACTICE FOR DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ESCALATORS AND MOVING WALKS
- 2. Previously, BCA had informed the industry through a circular issued on 8 June 2017 (reference: APPBCA-2017-08) of the upcoming replacement of CP15 with the new SS 626:2017 Code of Practice for Design, Installation and Maintenance of Escalators and Moving Walks as the acceptable standard for the design of escalators.

3. This amendment will be implemented on 1 March 2018. Projects whose first set of plans (either building plans or structural plans, whichever is earlier) is submitted to the Commissioner of Building Control for approval under the Building Control Act on and after 1 March 2018 must ensure that the escalators in the project are designed and installed in accordance with the relevant requirements in SS 626:2017.

# (B) NEW TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR LIFTS AND ESCALATORS

4. As previously informed through the circular (reference: APPBCA-2017-08) issued on 8 June 2017, new requirements for new lifts, and escalators will be included as part of the acceptable solution for the design of lifts and escalators. The new requirements are:

a. Light curtains as door	a. Step upthrust prevention

b. Emergency communication device for communication with

c. Video recording	

- 5. This amendment will be implemented on 1 March 2018. The requirements will apply only to new projects where the first set of plans (either building plans or structural plans, whichever is earlier) is submitted to the Commissioner of Building Control for approval under the Building Control Act on or after 1 March 2018.
- 6. Currently, stairlifts, vertical platform lifts and home lifts<sup>2</sup> already need to meet BCA's requirements under the Building Control Act and Building Control Regulations. For clarity, the Approved Document will now set out the specific standards acceptable to BCA for each lift type. They are as follows:
  - a. For vertical platform lifts:
    - i. EN 81-41 Safety rules for the construction and installation of lifts – Special lifts for the transport of persons and goods. Part 41: Vertical platforms intended for use by persons with impaired mobility:
    - ii. ASME 18.1 Safety standard for platform lifts and stairway chairlifts; or
    - iii. Other relevant standards which are acceptable to the Commissioner of Building Control

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> "Home lift" means a lift, not being common property, installed in a private home solely for the use of its occupants, but does not include a stairlift or a vertical platform lift.



#### b. For stairlifts:

- i. EN 81-40 Safety rules for the construction and installation of lifts – Special lifts for the transport of persons and goods. Part 40: Stairlifts and inclined lifting platforms intended for persons with impaired mobility;
- ii. ASME 18.1 Safety standard for platform lifts and stairway chairlifts; or
- iii. Other relevant standards which are acceptable to the Commissioner of Building Control.

### c. For home lifts:

- i. SS 550 Code of Practice for Installation, Operation and Maintenance of Electric Passenger and Goods Lifts; or
- ii. other relevant standards which are acceptable to the Commissioner of Building Control.
