ENHANCEMENT TO EARTH CONTROL MEASURES (ECM) REQUIREMENTS

Joint Audit Check by Contractor and QECP

This circular serves to inform the construction industry of the enhancement to the ECM requirements. The enhancement is to foster closer collaboration between the building

contractor and Qualified Erosion Control Professional (QECP) to ensure that effective ECM are

implemented at the construction site, so as to prevent silty water from affecting our

waterways.

2 Currently, building contractors are required to provide ECM at the construction sites

to prevent causing silty discharge. The ECM plan is designed by a QECP engaged by the

contractor. Besides designing the ECM, the roles of the QECP includes ensuring the ECM

installed on site is done according to the ECM Plan, conducting regular inspection of ECM

installed on site, revising ECM if needed in tandem with the project phasing, and providing

ECM expertise to the contractor.

3 From our site observations as well as engagement of QECPs via the quarterly QECP

Review Sessions, we noted that some contractors implemented ECM and carried out

earthworks without involving their QECP. In some cases, this approach has resulted in sub-

standard ECM, and caused silty water problem within the site and silty discharge affecting the

waterways.

4 To prevent the above problem, regulatory intervention is appropriate to catalyse a

closer ECM collaboration between the building contractors and their QECP, to ensure proper

implementation of ECM.

5 In consultation with Institution of Engineers, Singapore (IES), Association of Consulting

Engineers Singapore (ACES) and Singapore Contractors Association Limited (SCAL), we will

include the following requirement under the ECM Clearance Certificate:

A ECM audit check shall be jointly carried out by the contractor and his QECP within 6

months upon the start of the construction or one third of the project construction

period, whichever is shorter. The audit form, to be duly signed by the contractor and

QECP, shall be submitted to PUB within 2 weeks upon completion of the audit.

A sample audit form is attached.

Please note that:

• The above requirement can be executed as one of the regular ECM site inspections agreed

between the contractor and the QECP, as deemed necessary by the QECP for the project. It is

not meant to imply that one ECM site check by the QECP is suffice for the project duration.

Non-compliance with any requirements of the ECM Clearance Certificate including the above

requirement is an offence under the Sewerage and Drainage Act.

6 The above requirement will take effect for all ECM plan submissions made from 1 June

2019.
