THE INTER-AGENCY COORDINATING COMMITTEE (IACC) RESOLUTION PLATFORM

Objective

This circular is to invite industry to tap on the Inter-Agency Coordinating Committee (IACC) Resolution platform for expedient resolution of issues arising from conflicting regulatory requirements encountered by the project parties in their projects.

Background

2 IACC had earlier issued a circular on February 2019¹ to inform the industry on the commencement of a regular monthly IACC Resolution Meeting. A steady number of cases have been lodged by industry practitioners since February 2019, with a diverse spectrum of issues being raised across various levels of complexity.

3 IACC strives to expeditiously resolve project issues caused by conflicting regulatory requirements between two or more agencies, towards a goal of facilitating smooth completion of projects. Project parties who are encountering such problems are encouraged to write to the IACC Secretariat to seek resolution assistance.

Effectiveness of the IACC Resolution Platform

- Based on the record of cases lodged at the IACC Resolution platform, the number of cases tabled in first half of the year for 2021 has outpaced the cases tabled in the same period for 2019 & 2020 (13 cases in 2019; 12 cases in 2020 and 14 cases in the first half of 2021.) An increasing number of industry practitioners are recognising the benefits of the IACC Resolution platform. IACC continues to encourage more industry practitioners to surface their project issue(s) as early as necessary to avoid or minimise impasses in the project's clearance and construction processes.
- IACC targets to resolve cases expediently, depending on the complexity of the issues. Based on recent records², more than 75% of the cases lodged in 2021 were effectively resolved within 1-2 months. IACC aims to continue to improve the time taken to resolve cases as part of its enhanced resolution framework.

Application

The IACC resolution meeting is scheduled to convene once every month. Any project team may submit their request to IACC by providing the necessary project information and case details using the IACC case lodgement form³. The requestor may send the completed form to the IACC Secretariat by email to BCA_IACC_Secretariat@bca.gov.sg

The IACC Secretariat will follow up with the requestor on the necessary towards the resolution, and/or earliest available resolution meeting date⁴, if applicable.



Steps to table cases to the IACC Resolution Platform

STEP 1

Fill up the IACC Case Lodgement Form (*Annex B*).

STEP 2

Email the Case Lodgment Form (*Annex B*) together with all relevant information on the issue to:

STEP 3

IACC Secretariat will follow up via email with the relevant agencies and/or project parties for response and/or further clarifications respectively.

STEP 4

Issue resolved through Secretariat's facilitation over emails? YES \rightarrow Case Closed.

NO → Case tabled in next upcoming IACC Resolution Meeting.

Other IACC Initiatives

Coordinated Release of Circulars

- Arising from industry feedback, IACC has been coordinating the batch release of circulars across agencies for ease of tracking by the industry.
- Coordinated Release on 1st working day of: Mar, Jun, Sep, Dec.
- Since 2019 (H2) to 2021 (H1),
 69 circulars have been released in 9 batches.

- Since early 2020, the IACC worked with BCA Academy to develop an e-Learning Platform to familiarise QPs with regulatory submission requirements.
